Intent of the Design

The PS2 bailout bag is a versatile and robust system designed for emergency descent and bailout purposes. It offers multiple attachment options for descent devices, positions the anchor attachment strap for quick deployment, and provides ample storage capacity for rope, anchors, and descent devices, making it a valuable tool for firefighters and emergency responders.

OVERVIEW

Descent Device Attachment Options: The PS2 bailout bag offers flexibility in how the descent device can be attached. It can be pre-rigged to an escape belt or Class II harness worn on the pants. This allows for quick and easy deployment in case of an emergency. Additionally, it can be left unattached for escape belts that are worn over the coat, accommodating different gear configurations.

Anchor Attachment Strap: The anchor attachment strap is a crucial system component. It is connected to the emergency anchor and outside the turnout pants pocket. This positioning makes it very easy to deploy the bailout system rapidly. This feature is essential for ensuring a quick and efficient response in emergency situations.

Rope Capacity: The PS2 bailout bag can hold up to 30, 40, and 50 feet of 7.5mm rope. Additionally, it is capable of storing most anchors and descent devices. It is designed to be a comprehensive and versatile solution for emergency descent and bailout scenarios, accommodating various equipment needs.

PS2/XX are Pre-Rigged Bailout Kits

General Requirements

PS2.50 comes with 1 main rope area and 2 pouches that hold the descent device and anchor. The PS2 can hold up to 30', 40' to 50' of 7.5mm Escape rope. A Kevlar anchor pull-strap attaches to the anchor and folds over the turnout pocket for ease of deployment (optional use). The sides of the PS2 allow the bag to extend out and ventilate.

Materials

Fire-resistant vinyl 22oz material, nylon mesh sides, NFPA 1971 Velcro, and nylon thread.

Webbing

1" Kevlar is used on the anchor strap with Kevlar thread.

What was the primary reason for the PS2 Bailout Bag design?

Answer

The PS2 was designed to be a bailout kit, to be placed inside the turnout pant pocket. To have rugged material so it does not rub through the turnout pocket.

Question

Why PS2.50 instead of the PS2.40 or PS2.30?

Answer The PS2.50 holds 50' while the PS2.40 holds 40', and the

PS2.30 holds 30' of 7.5mm

Question

How do I pack the rope in the PS2 Bailout Bag?

Answer

Place rope right to left in the bag. Don't just grab a wad of rope and shove it in, the rope will not deploy. For more detailed information, click on the QR below this page.

Question

Is there any downside to the PS2 Pocket Bailout Bag?

Answer

The PS2 Bailout Bag is easily stowed in the turnout pant pocket, and it can potentially be very important on every call. However, some personnel may have concerns about the positioning of the device against the door of the apparatus or against the engine cover when driving. If this becomes a safety issue, or it interferes with the operation of the vehicle, it can simply be removed whole from the pocket until the destination.
